<p>Tier 1: Universal</p> <p>All students receive high-quality classroom curriculum through whole group, small group differentiated instruction, teacher-designed interventions by the classroom teacher within the general education setting.</p>	<p>Tier 2: Supplementary</p> <p>In addition to classroom instruction, students identified as needing intervention receive supplemental instruction aligned to the core curriculum that targets specific area or areas of need. Progress is monitored to determine improvement.</p>	<p>Tier 3: Intensive</p> <p>In addition to classroom and supplemental instruction, students needing intensive instruction to target specific skill deficits receive intensive instruction. Progress is monitored to determine improvement.</p>
