Job Title: Head Track and Field Coach
Reports to: Athletic Director
Division: Staff

General Purpose: The Bradenton Christian School Head Track and Field Coach will faithfully support Bradenton Christian School's mission statement to prepare the hearts and minds of God's covenantal children in partnership with the home and church for service in God's world. The Head Track and Field Coach will oversee all coaches and athletes in the Track and Field program and ensure the overall development of the program from the middle school level through the high school level.

Scope: This person interacts directly with coaches, parents, and students as a representative of Bradenton Christian School. The supervision of a coordinated program and oversight of assistant coaches are essential in this role.

Job Responsibilities:

We are looking for a Head Track and Field Coach who is a committed follower of Jesus, called to coach in a Christian School setting who can build our program and integrate faith with coaching.

- Develop a plan of discipleship at all levels of the program, ensuring that Christ is in the center of each team
- Maintain a spiritual and professional environment at all levels of the program
- Hire assistant coaches with the approval of the A.D.
- Supervise the coaching staff at all levels in the program to ensure athletes are growing spiritually, athletically, and socially
- Operate within the annual track and field budget
- Assist the athletic director in purchasing needs and equipment for the year
- Actively seek opportunities to raise financial support for items and equipment
- Conduct yearly evaluations for all coaches in the program
- Attend yearly coaching clinics and professional development opportunities
- Encourage assistant coaches to attend yearly professional development opportunities
- Attend mandatory meetings in the athletic department throughout the year
- Abide by and cooperate with the SSAC and FHSAA rules and regulations
- Partner with Human Resources to ensure all assistant coaches and sub-varsity coaches have successfully completed and passed appropriate background checks and fingerprinting prior to involvement in the program
- Plan, organize, and conduct summer camp(s) with the assistance of the facilities manager
- Work with the A.D. and trainer in regards to mandatory student paperwork that athletes must have completed prior to the first official practice date
- Partner with the trainer as needed for emergency care, injuries, and first aid as needed
- Complete an inventory of equipment and uniforms at the conclusion of each season
- Keep and report player stats
- Assist the A.D. with scheduling of events
- Encourage football players, as student athletes to participate in more than one sport at BCS

- Work cooperatively with other BCS programs and teams
- Create opportunities with our strength coach for off-season training and conditioning
- Coordinate coaching and player assignments for away events, as well as ensuring supervision when traveling off campus for events/practices
- Assist the athletic director with the sports banquet and signing days
- Conduct chapel prior to games when given the opportunity, open and close practices with prayer
- Keep stats for each game to ensure student/athlete records are documented and accurate for future years

Qualification And Skill Requirements:

- Effective Christ-like leader in all areas of life
- Ability to coordinate, instruct, motivate and organize a football team
- Strong commitment to the BCS mission and athletic philosophy
- Experience successfully coaching football in High School, College, or Professional
- Excellent management and organizational skills
- Skillful motivational techniques reflecting a positive attitude
- Desire to help and serve others as a team player
- Communicate and collaborate with coaches, parents, students, and teachers
- Bachelors degree or higher preferred
- Teaching Certificate preferred

Schedule & Physical Requirements:

- Work schedule will vary and may involve irregular hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays
- Frequent travel to away games required during the season
- Work is largely in an outdoor setting and will require long periods of standing
- Must be able to lift 15 pounds at times
