### **NEW PASSWORDS FOR STUDENTS**

Passwords for Charles County Public Schools (CCPS) students are changing September 1. The system-wide switch to the new passwords will take place around 4 pm on Friday. Students use their password to log in to 1:1 laptops, Microsoft365 and Synergy. The new password is visible to parents in Synergy.

The new password can be found in ParentVUE/StudentVUE accounts under Student Information menu when accessing the program through a web browser. If using the mobile app, click the Student Info/Additional Information menu to access the information. The new password will be in the same areas of ParentVue/StudentVue on September 1.

Any student new to CCPS will not have their password reset.

### **SAFETY REMINDER**

- Parents and students are reminded that students **may only be dropped off or picked up in the** main office parking lot. No drop-offs or pick-ups are permitted in tennis or pool lots.
- Only staff and student drivers with an official NPHS parking pass may enter the tennis lot.
- At no time should cars enter the bus lot during arrival and dismissal.
- At no time should parents enter the pool lot during arrival or dismissal.
- Both of these lots have a high volume of student foot traffic. Entering the bus and pool lots creates a potentially dangerous situation.
