2. Windermere Project

Kelly Nelli provided the following language for the bid package:

We further authorize the submittal of these plans, project manuals, and cost estimates to be submitted to the Office of School Construction Grants & Review for review.

They need 30 days to review – plans signed off however playground certificate not signed off on yet – don't see this being an issue, but is a missing piece to the PCR review on Monday. We cannot formally go out to bid with the playgrounds until plans are approved – everything else can be sent out to bid.

Kelly reviewed all signatures that she needed/she has obtained

Scott Nichol introduced Alisha Carapino, Director of Finance and Operations

Enabling on sitework is moving along – hit a lot of rock – up to \$75,000.00 in change orders to date – drainage is going through some ledge

Question asked – has anything been said from the people who live adjoining to the school Answer: no one has heard anything to date

Gary Magnuson noted that the plans went through planning and zoning so all neighbors had the chance to speak up

Peter noted that when construction starts, with an increase of noise, there may be calls then

Kelly noted that in the near future letters will be sent to those homes with the contact info for O&G, DRA, and Arcadis to contact with any questions or concerns
