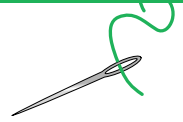
LEARN TO SEW

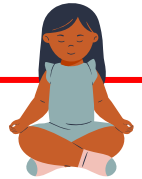


LET'S RELAX TOGETHER!

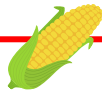

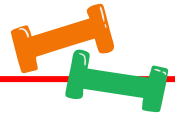
