



DAY TRIP TO ST. JOSEPH: EXPERIENCE MUST SEE HIGHLIGHTS

TUESDAY, SEPT. 26, 2023

Welcome to Missouri's first and last frontier located on the scenic river bluffs overlooking the Missouri River. St. Joseph, MO, is a contemporary city blended with more than 150 years of history. Established by Joseph Robidoux in 1826, this early Indian trading post quickly expanded into a major trade center and was incorporated as the city of St. Joseph in 1851.

The first stop of the trip will be the **Patee House Museum** which was chosen as a Top Ten Western Museum by True West magazine. This building was the headquarters for the Pony Express in 1860, and the finest hotel west of the Mississippi. Today it is a museum where you can climb aboard an 1860 train and ride the vintage Wild Thing carousel. The museum also houses an 1877 railroad depot, a stagecoach, wagons, buggies and carriages, race car, real gallows, a blacksmith shop, a dressmaker's shop, antique furniture and toys, and a wing designed to look like the streets of old St. Joseph in the 1860s-1880s. Just a few yards from the museum, the tour will continue with a brief visit to the house where Jesse James, an infamous American outlaw, bank, and train robber, was shot and killed by a fellow gang member.

The next stop will be the **Pony Express Museum** where you'll first enjoy a delicious catered lunch (see next page for details). After lunch, we will continue with a guided tour of the museum, which was designated as a Top Ten Western Museum by True West Magazine. The tour will consist of visiting the "Stables," the famous mail delivery service that started within those very walls on April 3, 1860. Your guide will give a personalized tour of exhibits covering the creation, running, and demise of the Pony Express.

Next, you'll visit the Pony School to take a step back in time for a lesson given to you by the schoolmarm and play games from days past in the one-room schoolhouse.



The last site will be the new **Walter Cronkite Memorial**, a tribute to legendary CBS news anchor and St. Joseph native. The permanent memorial is a collection of items designed to honor the famous news anchor. You'll tour a replica of the CBS newsroom where Walter reported the Nightly World News, and even sit in his chair to experience what it was like to

report to millions across America. You'll be able to explore through several kiosks where videos show details about his childhood, family, career, and actual clips of his broadcasts.

The last stop will be for some FREE refreshments at **Aspen Leaf** where you will be given a cup to fill with any number of combinations of frozen yogurt flavors and favorite toppings. Afterwards you can walk next door to the Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory and buy, if you wish, some chocolates to take home. Departing St. Joseph, we will drive by the practice field of the Super Bowl Champion KC Chiefs.



Raytown Quality Schools is offering to cover the cost of background checks for substitutes that apply in the 2023-24. Once you apply, you will be invited to come into the Human Resources office to meet with the HR Coordinator for substitutes. At this meeting you will pre-register online for fingerprinting through the State Highway Patrol's Missouri Automated Criminal History Site, and you will register online through the Department of Health & Senior Services.

Requirements to be a Substitute Teacher:

You must have either a current Missouri teaching certificate, have a current substitute certificate, or complete DESE's 20 hour substitute teacher training. To apply for your substitute certificate, visit: https://dese.mo.gov

Please provide a copy of your certificate to the district's HR Coordinator for substitutes.

Age Restrictions




