FL-023 AIR FORCE JROTC STUDENT CONTRACT 2023-2024

APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT FOR:

1. UNDERSTANDING: Belonging to the cadet corps is a privilege, not a right. The DeLand High School AFJROTC Instructors reserve the right to remove you from the AFJROTC program if you are not meeting the minimum standards spelled in this contract.

2. OBLIGATIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS: Participation in AFJROTC ***does NOT commit or obligate*** any student to military service. This is a citizenship program. However, completion of a minimum of three years of AFJROTC ***may*** qualify for advanced rank upon enlistment in the US Armed Forces. Additionally, students who complete two years of AFJROTC and are enrolled in their senior year are eligible to compete for AFJROTC scholarships. For those considering college ROTC, both instructors may write letters of recommendation on behalf of AFJROTC. Participation in the AFJROTC program alone does not guarantee a Letter of Recommendation. Cadets must demonstrate leadership, Esprit the Corps and Academic Excellence to be considered for this recognition.

3. CADET FEE: All cadets are required to pay a fee by 25 August as explained below:

a. New Cadet: \$40. These funds will be used to pay for the AFJROTC FL-023 Polo and discounted Mil Ball Ticket. All remaining funds will be used for travel expenses.

b. Returning Cadet: \$40. Discounted Mil Ball ticket. All remaining funds will be used for travel expenses.

4. APPLICATION: I hereby apply for enrollment in the FL-023 DeLand High School AFJROTC Program.

5. AGREEMENT: (Aerospace Science Instructors): The Senior Aerospace Science Instructor (SASI) and the Aerospace Science Instructor (ASI) agree to: (1) Provide instruction about aerospace science, leadership education, health and wellness, drill and ceremony, and management of the cadet corps; (2) Develop informed citizens; (3) Instill responsibility, accountability, character, attention to detail, and self-discipline; (4) Help students understand their role in a democratic republic; (5) Familiarize the students with the U.S. Air Force, other military branches, as well as the scholarships and career opportunities.

6. AGREEMENT: (Cadet) To maintain the high standards of courtesy, personal conduct, and appearance required by the USAF and FL-023 as a cadet, I understand and agree to:

A. Meet the standards of behavior, attitude, and courtesy established and taught by the Instructors and/or cadet staff. I understand and agree that indifference to training or discipline problems such as dishonesty, lying, stealing, cheating, skipping class/school, failure to follow directions of those in authority, initiating a fight, or suspension from school for misbehavior may result in immediate removal and/or non-selection for future enrollment in AFJROTC. **I will NOT disrespect, bully, haze, or harass any cadet, student, or teacher.** Any violations of these mandates will result in immediate removal from AFJROTC. ___/___ (Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

B. **I will wear the regulation Air Force uniforms (Blue uniform and AF Physical Training Uniform (AFPTU)) on those occasions prescribed by the SASI/ASI. If I fail or refuse to wear the uniform three times during the semester or improperly wear the uniform or don't comply with standards, I understand that I will be removed from AFJROTC. Removal from the program will result in a "F" in the course. Blues Day is normally every Wednesday, and AFPTU Day is normally Friday, but are subject to change.** ___/___ (Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

C. I will maintain the uniform in a clean, properly fitted, and in repaired manner. I will turn in the complete uniform upon demand. I am responsible for the cost of cleaning during the school year. Any loss, theft, or damage of uniform items will be at my expense. **All uniforms must be returned dry-cleaned and in cellophane bags with receipts attached. If this requirement is not met, cadet will be added to school obligation list.** The following is the **replacement cost** for issued uniform items. ___/___ (Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

D. **I WILL MEET AND MAINTAIN THE PERSONAL GROOMING STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE AIR FORCE.** I will pay particular attention to **military hair standards (Male and Female), facial hair, body piercing, tattoos, and body jewelry** as described in the AFJROTC Cadet Handbook. Instructors will make NO exceptions to grooming policies for ANY cadet, and failure to commit to grooming standards by the 3rd week of school will result in removal from the AFJROTC program. ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

E. I must maintain an acceptable standard of academic performance in **ALL** classes. I will complete **ALL** assignments and activities given to me by my instructors/teachers. I will be active in classroom work, online assignments, and activities of **ALL** classes. I must earn a final grade of “C” or better in AFJROTC and a “C” or better overall Grade Point Average each marking period to be eligible to participate in AFJROTC co-curricular activities. **(Cadets are expected to participate in at least TWO extra-curricular activities. Failure to accomplish this requirement will impact scholarship, and leadership opportunities).** I understand that a final grade of “D” or lower in AFJROTC will result in permanent dis-enrollment of the AFJROTC program. ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

F. I will respond positively to other cadets who have been appointed to leadership positions. Rendering proper military courtesies to instructors and other cadets with senior rank is **MANDATORY! I will express courtesy and respect to administrators, teachers, coaches, and other adults** with whom I come into contact (example: using sir/ma’am is mandatory when giving close-ended responses like “yes sir” and “no ma’am” as applicable). I will conduct myself properly when I am entrusted with a position of leadership. ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

G. I will meet the following objectives of the Cadet Group: (1) Respect self and others; (2) communicate at all levels; (3) foster teamwork and esprit de corps; (4) demonstrate **Integrity First, Service Before Self, and Excellence in All We Do**; (5) exhibit responsibility, character, and self-discipline and; (6) promote community service. ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

H. I will take proper care of AFJROTC materials (textbook/computer/rifles/sabers/etc.) provided by the AFJROTC and return them when requested. I will make payment to the AFJROTC office for any materials damaged or lost. ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

I. I will make diligent efforts to participate in and support **ALL** unit community service events and fundraising activities. ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).

J. I have read, understand, and **WILL COMPLY** with the requirements of and information provided to me in this contract and the FL-023 Cadet Handbook (www.delandhs.org/afjrotc). ***I have read the curriculum portion of the cadet guide and understand the make-up policies.*** ___/___(Cadet **AND** Parent/Guardian initials).
