If you have multiple children attending the Mashpee Public Schools, a separate form would be needed for each of your children.

Also enclosed is the *Title VI ED 506 Indian Education Eligibility Certification Form*. This form must be on file with the Mashpee Public Schools for each of our Native American students in order for us to secure our Indian Education Grant funding. Please complete this form and return it as well in the envelope provided. Your attention to these tasks is greatly appreciated.
