Crawfordsville Community School Corporation has partnered with Marzano Resources and their High Reliability Schools™ framework. Becoming highly reliable in your child's education is a key component to Crawfordsville Community School Corporation's strategic plan. Above all things is ensuring that your child has a safe, supportive, and collaborative culture to learn. Parents and students are a critical component to student achievement and gaining your input is valuable to our strategic planning. In an effort to ensure a safe, supportive, and collaborative culture we will be asking feedback from both parents and students via online surveys as part of our partnership with Marzano Resources. The survey window for K-12 students will be from October 9-13, 2023 and is only 12 questions long.

Indiana legislation through HEA 1447 outlines the following requirements:

- I. Requires schools to obtain parental consent before certain personal analyses, evaluations, or surveyed may be administered to a student;
- II. Requires qualified schools to post a copy of certain personal analyses, evaluations, and surveys to the school's website;
- III. Gives parents of students enrolled in qualified schools the right to review and inspect all materials related to certain personal analyses, evaluations, and surveys;
- IV. Restricts the manner in which the responses or results derived from certain personal analyses, evaluations, and surveys may be recorded, collected, or maintained; and
- V. Requires qualified schools to include specific provisions in their contracts with third-party vendors that provide certain personal analyses, surveys, or evaluation.

Student feedback is a valuable component to CCSC sustaining a safe, supportive, and collaborative culture. Student responses will not be identifiable to specific students and if a student doesn't feel like they have the necessary information to answer a question they are able to select "N/A or don't know" for that specific question.
