WHAT IS A SBHC

We offer **Medical, Mental health, and Dental** services for students at Elma Elementary School. We offer services through both telehealth and in-person appointments.

- Well child checks and immunization referrals
- Evaluation and treatment of common health problems
- Medication management
- Prevention and early intervention mental health services
- Oral health care screenings and treatment referrals
- Preventative health care, including health education
- Health insurance eligibility and enrollment assistance
- Health care providers and specialists referrals as needed

The Elma Elementary SBHC is located in the Elma School District office.



WHY

A SBHC fosters learning readiness and academic achievement ensuring students' health needs are met. Students can then focus on learning, playing, growing and thriving.



WHEN

Health care services are offered during regular school hours as well as some before-and/or after-school hours.
