FOSTER CARE STUDENT SUPPORTS

Documents Needed to Enroll a Foster Care Student in a Public School:



- Birth Certificate or other proof of identity
- Copy of previous school records
- Proof of immunizations
- Placement Authorization form (2085)
- Copy of child's school records

Ensure foster student access to the free and reduced lunch school programs.



Fees for technology devices, electives, tests, and dual credit courses are waived.

Students receiving specialized services via special education or section 504 residing in residential facilities, where parental rights are revoked, require a school or court appointed surrogate parent.



Foster parents, surrogate parents and DFPS caseworkers have the same rights as a parent.



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The Every Student Succeeds Acts (ESSA) provides protections for your foster care student under the provisions of federal and state law. To promote school stability, foster care students have provisions to remain in their school or origin at the time of placement. This provisions permits access to continue in the same school despite district rezoning and foster placement changes, if found to be in the best interest of the student.
