IMPORTANT THINGS TO CONSIDER

- ❖ Sport Scholarship candidates would normally be of County/Academy standard, although if this level has not been reached, awards may be based on their potential. Each boy is expected to demonstrate exceptional talent or potential in at least one sport in which he would make a significant contribution to School life.
- ❖ This is not an 'all-rounder' award, but an award for excellence in a particular sport. Candidates can only be assessed in a maximum of three sports, but ideally less.
- ❖ **Cricket, Tennis** and **Athletics** are all summer sports therefore candidates can only be assessed in one.
- ❖ We will request a confidential reference from the candidate's school leading up to the assessment period in February.
- ❖ Scholarship-only candidates who perform to an exceptionally high standard will still be asked to sit academic tests before being considered for a guaranteed place.
