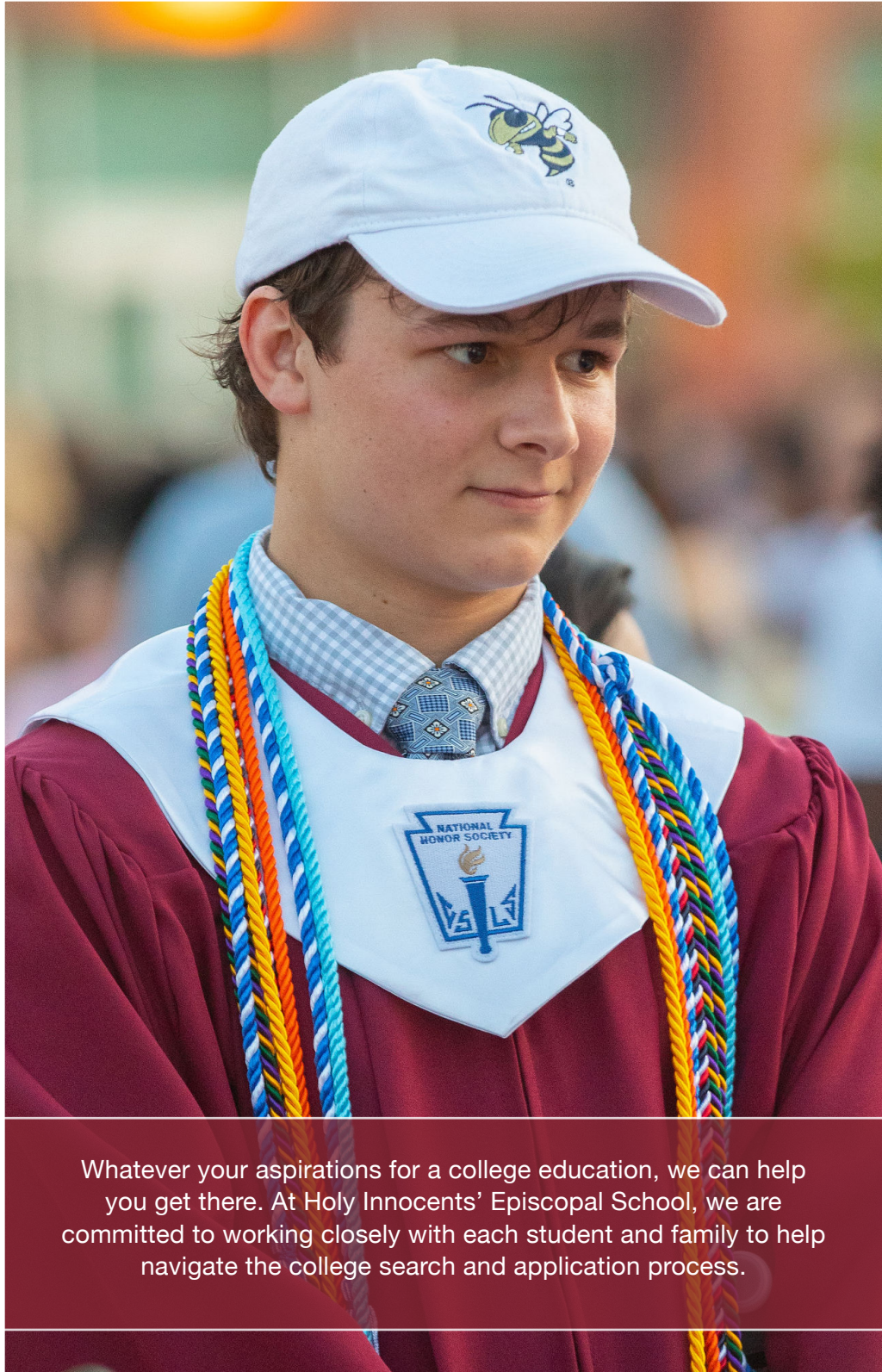


## OUR HI-STORY AND MISSION
