Transitional Housing and Rapid Re-Housing Information

Licking County Coalition for Housing (LCCH) provides two types of programs for homeless households: Transitional Housing (TH) and Rapid Re-Housing (RRH). While both programs offer case management and will work with you in obtaining permanent housing, they are structured differently.

Below are some differences between the two programs. If you are denied for the TH program, you may still be eligible for RRH. Please speak with your Coordinator about barriers you may encounter to obtaining permanent housing so they can assist you in finding the program to fit your housing needs. Contact LCCH or speak with your Coordinator about any questions you may have about the different programs available.

Transitional Housing

- Living temporarily in a LCCH-owned unit
- Sign Resident Contract with LCCH
- Furnished Apartment
- LCCH will have keys to your unit
- Contact LCCH for maintenance
- Fee is paid in lieu of monthly rent
- Background check is completed by LCCH prior to entry
- Will meet with a case manager on a monthly basis at minimum
- Must be homeless prior to entry
- Meetings will consist of office and home visits

Rapid Re-Housing

- LCCH does not own the property
- Sign a lease with the landlord
- Furniture is not provided
- Landlord will have keys to your unit
- Contact the landlord for maintenance
- Monthly rent will be paid to the landlord
- Background/credit checks may be completed by the landlord
- Will meet with a case manager on a monthly basis at minimum
- Must be homeless prior to entry
- All meetings consist of home visits

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
