TITLE I FAMILY ENGAGEMENT POLICY

All students at White Hall Elementary participate in a federally funded school-wide Title I program. The purpose of Title I is to ensure that all students have access to a high quality education and reach proficiency on grade level academic standards.

In accordance with the requirements of the Title I Family Engagement Policy, White Hall Elementary will:

1. Hold an annual meeting to inform families about the Title I program and its requirements
2. Provide families with timely information about the the Title I program through various communication channels
3. Provide families with a description of the curriculum used, the forms of academic assessments used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet through informational packets and/or informational meetings at the start of the school year
 - a. Provide assistance to families in understanding the State's academic standards
 - b. Provide materials and opportunities for training for families to improve student achievement
 - c. Provide regular information regarding individual student progress and assessment data with opportunities for consultation
4. Encourage family engagement
 - a. Parent/guardian meetings, including parent teacher conferences, will be held at different times during the day to accommodate various schedules
 - b. Title I funds may be utilized to pay for expenses associated with family engagement activities in an effort to eliminate barriers for participation in school-related meetings and training sessions
 - c. Partner with the Family Resource Center and the Migrant Program to ensure families are made aware of the resources, such as agencies, materials, and services available to them
5. Involve families in the planning, review, and improvement of the Schoolwide Title I Program and the Family Engagement Policy
 - a. Families will be invited to provide feedback and offer suggestions through various surveys occurring throughout the school year
 - b. Families will be invited to serve as a parent/guardian representative on White Hall's Title I Advisory Team
 - c. Provide additional opportunities to meet and offer suggestions, if requested by a parent/guardian
6. Distribute the school-family compact that is jointly developed with families and outlines how families, the entire school staff, and students will share in the responsibility for improved student achievement
7. Review the Title I Family Engagement Policy annually and make revisions as needed
