What is DEIC?

DEIC is a key committee in assisting with the growth and improvement of Keller ISD. The parents, community members, and staff serving on the DEIC provide feedback and recommendations to district leadership on how we move forward together to make Keller ISD an even more exceptional district in which to learn, work, and live.

What does a typical DEIC meeting entail?

The first meeting begins with a “State of the District” update from our superintendent. After Dr. Westfall shares timely updates and answers committee member questions, district administrators share information on topics such as finance, technology, or student learning. Administrators might ask for feedback on next steps, communication gaps, strategy, etc. We also share reports on topics such as student achievement, graduation, bullying prevention, and professional development.

How can I get involved?
