2023-2024 School Wide Goals

1. To increase our SPS score from 62.1 by 5 points.
2. Students will enter the next grade level ready.
Kindergarten (Increase from 89%), first grade (Increase from 44%), and second (Increase from 43%)
3. Students will achieve mastery level on third-grade assessments and enter fourth grade prepared for grade-level content (Increase from 35% ELA & 26% Math)
4. Increase the % of students with disabilities and students of color attaining mastery on the state assessments.
5. Students will increase instructional time through a strong attendance record and more time in the classroom.
