7250 SCHOOL AND FACILITY NAMES

The Board has the ultimate responsibility for naming any of its facilities, buildings, or new schools.

The Superintendent will meet with the Alternative Revenue Committee and recommend to the full Board any naming that will produce revenue to the district.

The superintendent or designee will establish criteria to be used in naming facilities, buildings or new schools after individual(s) who were either employed or served the district. Name(s) meeting the criteria will be brought to the board for approval.

It is not necessary that names be selected for all of the district's facilities or buildings. When it has been determined that the naming of a facility or building is appropriate, a name (or several names) is (are) to be recommended by the Superintendent and approved by the Board no sooner than one year following the end of the individual's employment or service to the district nor should there be any fund-raising activity preparations without prior approval of the naming by the Board.

Names selected to be applied to any facility or building shall be free from biases, prejudices, or political, and/or religious connotations.

In selecting a name for a school, the Board shall consider the location, community and local heritage.

A school shall be named in sufficient time to properly identify all plans, specifications, and legal documents essential to its construction.
