    - Math: Mid-year or end-of-the-year test from the adopted math series.
- D. DECISION FOR APPROPRIATE PLACEMENT IS MADE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT, OR HIS/HER DESIGNEE, FOLLOWING CONSULTATION WITH PARENTS.
- E. The Kennewick School District reserves the right to reassign a student to another grade level within 30 school days of reentry from a home-based instruction program. The reassignment will occur only after the classroom teacher notifies the school principal of his/her concern about the appropriateness of the original placement and requests that a standardized achievement test be given.
