

WHAT IS THE SCOPE? (CONTINUED)

Columbus

- A secure entrance vestibule will be constructed, along with multiple enhancements in safety and security.
- Several classrooms will be renovated to support small group instruction.
- Music spaces will be enlarged and transformed to accommodate group collaboration and instruction, including band, chorus, and a future orchestral program.
- A new Makerspace/STEM Lab and three classrooms will be added.

Westlake Middle School

- A secure entrance vestibule will be constructed, along with multiple enhancements in safety and security.
- All four science labs will receive renovations.
- Both original locker rooms will be remodeled.

Shared Westlake Middle School High School Library

- Completely redesigned into a modern media center in which students will have the flexibility to research, create, learn, and innovate.

Westlake High School

- Multiple safety and security enhancements including the creation of a secure entrance vestibule and common space for continued student use.
- Gut renovation of the theater: lighting, rigging, acoustical and aesthetic improvements.
- All science labs will be reorganized and/or renovated.
- Studio art classroom will be fully renovated, and a new STEM Lab/Makerspace to support innovation, engineering, and robotics will be constructed.
- Cafeteria and kitchen renovations.

WHO CAN VOTE IN THE ELECTION?

Any resident of the School District who is registered to vote in general elections is qualified to vote at said meeting without having their name placed upon the School District register of voters provided they voted at a general election at least once within the last four calendar years. Further, provided that any person who has previously registered to vote in any annual School District meeting or election or special School District meeting or election and who has voted at an annual School District meeting or election or special School District meeting or election held during the past four years (2022, 2021, 2020, 2019) shall not be required to re-register.
