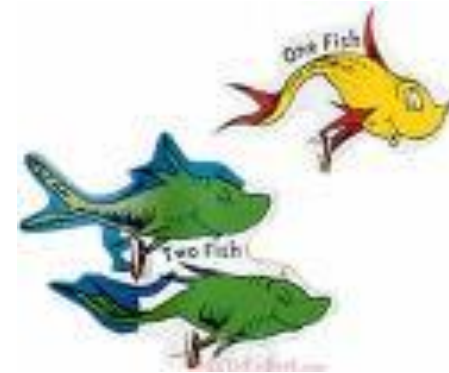

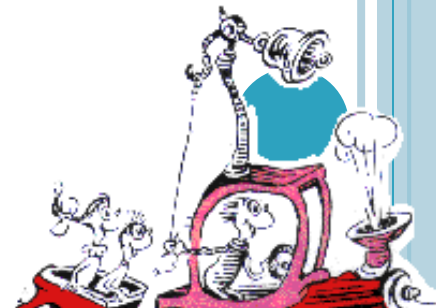


Y CARE – BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE
