Dear Parents/Guardians and Seniors,

We certainly want you to know that we miss you and wish that your last months with us would have been different. Health, wellness, and safety are the most critical matters to all of us these days!

What is also important is to make sure that as Superintendent, I can verify and accept you as a graduate of Hobart High School by the certification process your counselors and administrators have done to prove that you have **all credits** required within the guidelines given by the state. **All credits** are required to graduate! **Credits** are earned by passing classes. Please read the following very carefully!

You are required to attend 160 days. Classes for seniors will end on May 1st. Please be online and communicate with your teachers in classes as scheduled in eLearning through May 1st to finalize your class completion. Do not skip this! Your quarter and semester grades are dependent on this for earned credits. **Please get this quarter done with all assignments completed by May 1st so we can certify that you are ready for graduation. #FinishStrong!**

In order to turn around a 3rd quarter failure and receive credit for second semester, you must earn at least a D in eLearning this 4th quarter for that course. **It is not my expectation that you do minimal work. Always do your best!** This is an absolute! You will not graduate if this does not happen because you will be short credits!

All seniors already enrolled in or needing **credit recovery** classes must do so and complete them by May 1st to earn **credits** needed to graduate. This is an absolute! You will not graduate if this does not happen because you will be short credits!

Alternative education seniors must communicate their status on **credits** with Mrs. Waldron and Mrs. Newell. May 1st is a deadline for you to accomplish work needed to graduate.

ISTEP and Graduation Pathway requirements have been waived by the state.

Porter County Career and Technical Education (PCCTE) students must finish the requirements of their class. Please verify with Mrs. Brumley when your end date is, as it is dependent upon the program.
