LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

Year 1 have started some work on fractions! They have been learning how to split shapes and objects in half and can recognise that a half is two equal parts of a whole. We also started a new Art topic called 'Street View.' The children enjoyed looking at the buildings around our school and drawing thumbnail sketches of windows, chimneys and doors. In PE we have been practicing our jumping skills.

Ask me: How many halves make a whole?









Year 2 continued their fractions journey this week, looking at quarters and three quarters. In Science the children explored the playground and garden, identifying and counting creatures in their micro habitats. The children used their data to produce some excellent tables and graphs to represent their findings. In topic work the children re-enacted the demise of Edward the Confessor, the rise and fall of King Harold and the subsequent victory of William the Conqueror. Working in groups they sequenced sections of the Bayeux Tapestry from Edward the Confessor to King William the Conqueror.

Ask me: What happened at the Battle of Hastings in 1066?







Year 3/4 Home The children at school have enjoyed lots of fun activities at school this week including: maths games, salt dough and mini comic books. On Thursday afternoon they went on a lovely Eco Scavenger Hunt organised by Eton College: children had to find clues along the route which gradually revealed a nature-themed hidden word.

Ask me: What was the endangered bird revealed as 'the word' from our Scavenger Hunt?









Year 3/4 Away The children have had an amazing time at Grittleton House Adventure Centre. The days have flown by and have been filled with numerous activities including: karting, low ropes, bush craft, archery, water wars and all topped off with marshmallows round the camp fire. The children have developed their skills of being independent and have all shown increased confidence and team work. What a great trip!

Ask me: what new skills have I learnt?









This week, **Reception** began their new project 'Creep, Crawl & Wriggle'. They looked back at photos from their trip to the Eton College Natural History Museum a couple of weeks ago and remembered all of the information they were told about mini-beasts. They also went on a mini-beast hunt around the garden to see how many they could find.
