LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

This week **Year 1** have had a great first week back. In Maths, they have enjoyed learning how to count in 2s. In English, they have been learning to join sentences using the conjunctions 'and' 'or' and 'but.' The children have started their new 'School Days' topic and have begun to think about what school might have been like for Victorian children. We had a fantastic trip to Windsor Castle learning more about Queen Victoria and what life was like during her reign.

Ask me: What were Victorian schools like?







Year 2 have had a fantastic first week back to school! We have started our new history topic Magnificent Monarchs and have started to explore some new vocabulary. This was supported by our exciting day at Windsor Castle where we enjoyed a 'meet the monarch' workshop where we learnt all about Kind Charles III. We have also started to learn about fractions in maths, beginning the recognising parts and wholes which we now understand brilliantly! It has been an exciting first week back and we can't wait to see where this new term will take us!

Ask me: Why is King Charles called 'King Charles III?'







Year 3 have started the summer term with great enthusiasm! The children are enjoying our new history project 'Emperors and Empires' where they have been learning about life in Roman times. In our 'Myths and Legends' English lesson we have been reading the story of 'Romulus and Remus' and considering how Rome got its name. In computing the classroom turned into a court room for a lesson on cyber-crime – the children took on the roles of barristers and members of the jury as they determined whether or not a defendant had broken the law!

Ask me: How did Rome get its name?





Year 4 have enjoyed starting their new topic - Ancient Civilisations. The topic links in with the class reader and the discoveries of Howard Carter. In PE the children played touch rugby over on the Eton School Astro pitches. They thoroughly enjoyed learning some of the rules, playing super sixes as well as other fun games.

Ask me: What makes a civilisation?









This week, Reception began their new topic 'Animal Safari'. On Wednesday, they enjoyed an exciting trip to Chessington to observe a variety of different animals. The children went on a 'Zufari' ride and saw giraffes, zebras, rhinos, gorillas and much more! They also enjoyed a visit to the Eton College Natural History Museum on Friday to learn about mini-beasts in preparation for their mini project which they will begin in a few weeks' time.

Ask me: Can you name an omnivore and a carnivore?
