Dear Parents/Carers,

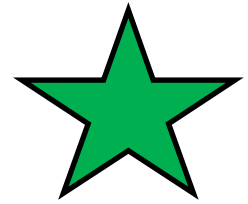

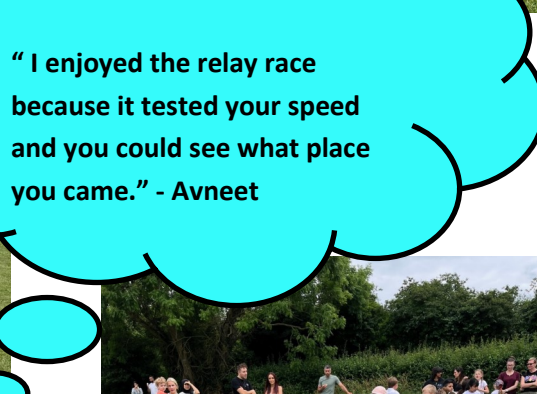

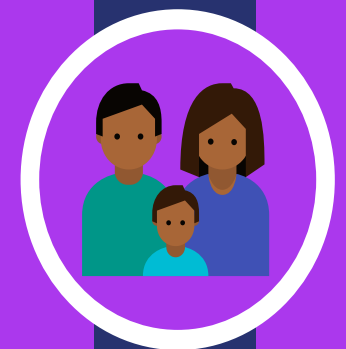


Practical Strategies
