LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

Year **One** loved their PE lessons this week! The children worked on their focusing and played lots of games to develop their focus skills. They particularly enjoyed playing with the parachute and working as a team to get the ball to the centre of the parachute! Ask me: What does focus mean?



Year 2 began the art topic Mix It this week. We read the story Mix It Up! By Herve Tullet and we developed our knowledge of primary and secondary colours. We discussed what might happen if you add more of one colour and less of the other. We used vocabulary like 'bright' and 'dull' to describe what the secondary colours looked like! Ask me: what secondary colour is made by mixing red and blue or yellow and red?



Year 3 have continued their learning about colours by creating a piece of artwork that demonstrated their knowledge of colour theory. They first looked at artists work, then identified and mixed the colours. They chose their favourite collection of colours to use for their own artwork.

Ask me: Which was my favourite painting to look at and why?

Year 4 have enjoyed completing their weaving projects and will be bringing their creations home. The children will now start to explore water colours in Art. In Maths they completed Place Value and will move on to Addition and Subtraction. Earlier in the week, some of the children competed against other local schools in dodgeball. Story writing has been a particular favourite this week. The children have all chosen part of Arthur's journey to write about and have been focussing on including fronted adverbials, descriptive language and paragraphs.

This week, Reception continued exploring their project 'Build it up'. One of their challenges this week was to engage in a game of 'Jenga' using a variety of skills to complete the game. The children had to use their fine motor skills to build the tower and then use their problem solving, sharing and turn taking skills to complete the game. 
