# **ERHS Parking Lot Information**



- Furniture and Things Facility has designated parking from 8:00am to 4:00pm on school days. No student parking.
- ERHS visitor parking, no student parking.
- Students can NOT park in these areas (Signs are posted)
- If a ticket is placed on a Vehicle in the lot. Student must bring ticket to main office no later than the following day.

# Drop Off / Pick Up Main Lot (ALL DAY) .



- The green lane is a pass through lane- no stopping, vehicles must continue to move forward, this is an open lane- UNLESS pedestrians are crossing - <u>yield to</u> <u>pedestrians- drive slow!</u>
- Drop off occurs in the <mark>red lanes</mark> only, no parking.
- The right red lane and the middle red dashed lanes are designed to function like the Mpls/St. Paul Airport for drop off/pick upinterchanging, patience, safety, and cooperation!
- No vehicles will be allowed to stop on School Street while waiting to pick up/drop off. It is expected that vehicles may/will be stopped in the red lanes. Pull forward as far as possible to accommodate the volume of pick up/drop off vehicles.

# E-Learning Day Guidelines | 2022-2023 School Year

### Why e-Learning Days?

E-Learning Days are intended to provide access to learning on days when there are school cancellations due to inclement weather. These days cannot replace the face-to-face time students have with their teachers, but it can provide continuous learning when school is canceled. E-Learning Days also eliminate the need for makeup days at the end of the school year, helping families plan summer activities.

# Important Information

- •Cancellations will be announced via phone, email, district website and social media indicating that there will be an e-Learning day.
- Teachers, principals, and other licensed professionals will be available by email or phone (via voicemail) from 9:00 am 3:00 pm. Staff contact information can be found in the <u>ISD 728 Staff Directory</u>. Staff will respond to all communication requests in a timely manner during scheduled hours.

### Attendance

Attendance will be based on the completion of the work for e-Learning Days. Students who do not have the necessary resources may make arrangements with the teacher for additional time to complete the work.

Student work on e-Learning Days will follow the guidelines below.


### Middle School and High School

Our students in grades 6-12 will utilize <u>Schoology</u> in order to access their assignments and expectations on an eLearning Day. Staff will post their course expectations in their Schoology Course by 9 a.m. on an eLearning Day. These expectations will be posted in the Schoology Updates section or located at the top of the Materials section.

Students will receive the eLearning Day activities for each class through Schoology. Course work may include but is not limited to online discussions, quizzes/assessments, online readings, completing assignments using digital resources such as Google or other web-based tools. In some cases, students may be directed to complete offline activities such as textbook readings or other assignments. Students and parents should contact their child's teacher if they have any questions regarding coursework.


