

## From the Health Office....

### ***Emergency Care Plans***

Emergency care plans (allergy, asthma, diabetes and seizures) allow school health services personnel to respond quickly to treat your child, minimize classroom disruption, potentially eliminate emergency room visits, and assist your child's quick return to the classroom.

In preparing for the 2022-2023 school year, it is important to complete the appropriate medical information for your child prior to the school year starting. Each emergency care plan must be signed by a physician and parent/guardian, and updated annually to ensure accurate information.

For appropriate forms to be completed by your child's health care provider, please refer to the Health Services [webpage](#). These forms and medication can be dropped off during your child's open house.

## 12th Grade

Minnesota law requires that all students entering 12th grade show proof of the following immunizations:

1. **Meningococcal (MCV4): 2nd dose** (First dose was required for 7th grade)

All students are expected to be in compliance with the state immunization laws on the first day of the 2022 - 2023 school year (September 6, 2022). Students who fail to provide proof of immunization will be at risk for exclusion from school.

If you choose not to vaccinate your child for medical or personal reasons, complete the [exemption form](#), write the name of the vaccine(s) you object to, and have the form notarized.

All forms can be returned to your child's building during your child's open house.

# E-Learning Day Guidelines | 2022-23 School Year

## Why e-Learning Days?

E-Learning Days are intended to provide access to learning on days when there are school cancellations due to inclement weather. These days cannot replace the face-to-face time students have with their teachers, but it can provide continuous learning when school is canceled. E-Learning Days also eliminate the need for makeup days at the end of the school year, helping families plan summer activities.

## Important Information

- Cancellations will be announced via phone, email, district website and social media indicating that there will be an e-Learning day.
- Teachers, principals, and other licensed professionals will be available by email or phone (via voicemail) from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm. Staff contact information can be found in the [ISD 728 Staff Directory](#). Staff will respond to all communication requests in a timely manner during scheduled hours.

## Attendance

Attendance will be based on the completion of the work for e-Learning Days. Students who do not have the necessary resources may make arrangements with the teacher for additional time to complete the work.

## Student Work Guidelines

Student work on e-Learning Days will follow the guidelines below.



## Elementary School

Students will receive an e-Learning Day choice board to bring home. They can also be accessed online by visiting the [district](#) or school website. Students complete a portion of the activities as directed, record them on the choice board, and send back to school with an adult/caregiver signature. K-5 parents can visit the website below to access the Choice Boards.

## Middle School and High School

Our students in grades 6-12 will utilize [Schoology](#) in order to access their assignments and expectations on an eLearning Day. Staff will post their course expectations in their Schoology Course by 9 a.m. on an eLearning Day. These expectations will be posted in the Schoology Updates section or located at the top of the Materials section.

Students will receive the eLearning Day activities for each class through Schoology. Course work may include but is not limited to online discussions, quizzes/assessments, online readings, completing assignments using digital resources such as Google or other web-based tools. In some cases, students may be directed to complete offline activities such as textbook readings or other assignments. Students and parents should contact their child's teacher if they have any questions regarding coursework.

## District Office Artwork


Every spring two works of art from each of the ISD 728 schools are selected, photographed, framed and displayed at the District Office for the following school year.
