Transcript Request

Students going onto a secondary education will be required to submit a FINAL TRANSCRIPT to that location. Your final transcript will include your grades from second semester and will list your graduation date.

Final Transcripts are <u>Not</u> automatically sent so **ORDER NOW** to ensure that your final transcript is sent before you begin in the fall.

ORDER TRANSCRIPT

Current students can order their transcripts free of charge, orders placed after July 1 will be charged a \$4.15 fee for electronic orders.

For students in **Grades 9 & 10** next year, the pick-up and drop-off location will automatically revert to the home address for the 2022-2023 school year. For students who will be in **Grades 11 & 12** next year and need transportation, a parent or guardian <u>must request</u> bus transportation using the <u>Student Transportation</u> <u>Information Form</u> for the 2022-2023 school year.

If everything will remain the same for next school year, simply select the option to "Confirm NO CHANGES to current address for 22-23 School Year" on the <u>Student Transportation Information Form</u>. Please fill out one form for each child who will ride.

If changes are needed for next school year, please complete a new or updated Student Transportation Information Form for the 2022-2023 School Year, using the appropriate selection for what is changing. *Please fill out one form for each child who will ride.*

Food Service Account Balance - Options for <u>Graduating Seniors</u>

For Seniors who are graduating, the Food Service Department will generate food service meal account refunds. Any funds remaining will be applied against other outstanding fees first, and then a payment refund will be automatically generated.

As in past years, there are 2 alternative options for Graduating Seniors:

- 1. Request the balance be transferred to a younger sibling.
- 2. Request the balance be donated to the District to help other families in need.
