#### Message from the Health Office:

<u>Continue to report positive Covid Cases</u>: Please continue to report your student's positive test result via the district reporting form by using this <u>link</u>.

Antigen Take Home Test Kits: ISD 728 has rapid antigen tests available for symptomatic students. If your student is experiencing COVID-like symptoms, you may request a "self administered" BinaxNOW OTC antigen test from your student's <u>health office</u>. This out-of-school testing program is intended to provide quick access to testing if a student has developed symptoms. Families are encouraged to watch this <u>video</u> in preparation to administer the test. Results are available to the family after approximately 15-30 minutes. These results are not shared with the school or district and it is the sole responsibility of the family to report a positive test by using this link.

<u>School Self-Screening Checklist:</u> Please continue to monitor your student's when they are feeling if by following the <u>School Self-Screening Checklist.</u> If your student has a pending COVID test, please keep your student home until all test results have been received.


