We ask <u>ALL</u> ISD 728 families that will need transportation for next fall to complete a <u>Student Transportation Information Form</u> for the 2021-2022 School Year.

Even if your student has been riding previously and nothing has changed, we ask that you complete a new student transportation form for the 2021-2022 school year.



In preparing for the 21 - 22 school year, it is important to complete the appropriate medical information for your child as soon as possible. Immunization and sport physical dates that the school has received for your child are posted on Parent Portal.

Immunization requirements reflect the current school year only. which are posted on July 1st of each school year.

Please note: Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines are required for beginning 7th grade, and a Meningococcal booster is required for 12th graders.
