REMINDERS

- Students who are designated face-to-face learners do not have the option to 'work from home'. Students are required to be in attendance Monday - Thursday (virtual Fridays). If a face-to-face student is absent due to illness, appointment, or plans to take a vacation, parents/guardians must report it to the attendance line.
- Students who are designated 100% Distance Learners must continue to "check-in" for daily attendance through Campus.
- Temporary Distance Learning is reserved for students who are in quarantine. School staff will

PANDEMIC-EBT BENEFITS FOR FAMILIES FOR 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

Students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals may be eligible for Pandemic-Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) to purchase food for days they are not in the school building. To be considered, households must submit an application for free or reduced-price meals for the 2020-21 school year or be approved for Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits.

Families who received P-EBT benefits last summer are not automatically eligible; eligibility is based on the current school year.

Beat the Rush - Get your Student's Sports Physicals and Immunizations




In preparing for the 2021-2022 school year, it is important to complete the appropriate medical information for your child as soon as possible.

Immunization and sport physical dates that the school has received for your child are posted on Parent Portal. Immunization requirements reflect the current school year only which are posted on July 1st of each school year.

Please note: Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines are required for beginning 7th grade, and a Meningococcal booster is required for 12th graders.
