## Referral and Admission Guidelines

### Who Do We Serve?

Any Warren County Public School student who may:

- Be falling behind in school or wanting to get ahead.
  - Be in their third year of High School regardless of grade.
  - Have a child or is expecting.
  - Be self-supporting/emancipated or married.
  - Have few discipline referrals and good attendance.
  - Have NOT graduated from high school in 4 years. (5<sup>th</sup> yr. Senior)
- ❖ Students with an IEP will not be referred without approval from the Director of Special Education.
- ❖ Student with a PSP will not be referred without approval from the Director of EL Programs.

**The Principal of Lighthouse Academy has the discretion and possesses the authority to accept and/or decline any applicant.**

### Admission Requirements:

- Attendance: **Students Must Be** in good standing with the home school
- *Third year of high school.*
- *Six credits on transcript.*
- Referral from home school.
- Guardian permission.
- Interview involving student and legal guardian at Lighthouse.
- Acceptance by LA Principal.
- **Student is expected to graduate from LA once enrolled.**
- **Minimal behavior referrals from home school.**
- **Student progress at his/her own pace and may graduate early.**  
**This may affect KEES money.**

Referrals will only be accepted from Greenwood, South Warren, Warren Central and Warren East High Schools. Transferring out of district students may enroll with approval from Alternative School principal.
