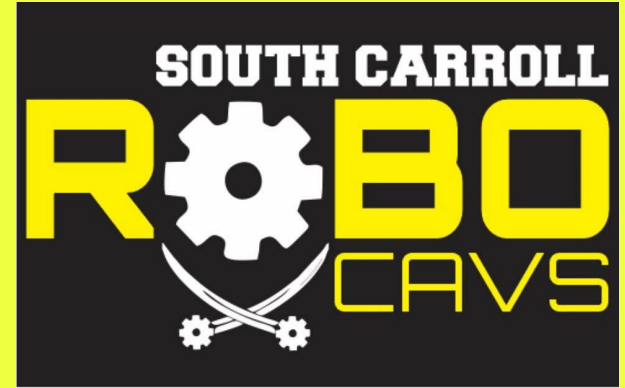
Robotics Club
