STUDENT ATTENDANCE

It is critical for all children to be in attendance at school daily. We do realize that from time to time children do get ill, and they should be home. Excusable reasons to keep your child home would be: running a temperature, vomiting, infection that has not been treated with antibiotics for at least 24 hours, funerals, or doctor appointments that cannot be made outside of school time.

You must phone the 24 hour Hotline at (330)875-7609 or call the school at (330)875-2661 before 9:30 am to report your child off of school. When reporting your child off of school, you may also request for homework to be sent home with another student or you can pick it up in the office 3:00-3:30. Upon return to school, the student must bring a written excuse or doctor's slip for an absence to be considered excused.





RAPTOR: VISITOR CHECK IN SYSTEM

Please present a valid government-issued driver's license with you every time you come to NN. Office staff will scan it and check a public records database. If cleared, you will receive a badge to wear in the building. An ID is required each time you visit a LCS building during school hours. Thank you for your understanding in keeping our students safe.

FORMS & HANDBOOK

The online forms that were sent via email in early August must be filled out online as soon as possible. This includes the following online forms: Parent/School Commitment Compact Form, Emergency Medical Form, Acceptable Use of Technology Form, Inflatable Permission Form, and the acknowledgment of the Student/Parent Handbook. Be sure to look through the handbook to have a clear understanding of policies and procedures of the Louisville City School district. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.

BEHAVIOR CHART

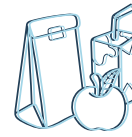
