Packing List for Outdoor Education Trips

- Shorts – one or two per day
- T-Shirts – 2 per day
- Long Pants – for horseback riding
- Long sleeved shirt or sweatshirt
- Rain Jacket or Poncho
- Socks and Underwear
- Sneakers – 2 pair
- Sandals for the beach
- Pajamas
- Bathing Suit
- Sheets and Blanket or Sleeping Bag (twin size beds)
- Pillow and Pillow Case
- Bath Towel
- Beach Towel
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, hand soap, etc.)
- Water Bottle

Optional:

- Shoes with a Heel for Horseback Riding
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Flashlight with Batteries
- Laundry Bag (trash bag will work)

Clothing: Most of the activities at camp are going to happen outdoors, so please do not bring new clothing. Everything that comes to camp has a chance to get wet or dirty.

Spending Money: Tuition covers everything students will need while they are at camp, and therefore, additional spending money is not needed.

Luggage: Students will be carrying their luggage to their cabin. Plan to condense all personal items into one or two manageable sized bags/suitcases.
