Waiting time may vary 0 to 15 minutes depending on the daily schedule.	<p>2 MINUTES: Pediatric Urgent Care provides telemedicine services to the schools of El Paso ISD and direct to the homes of thousands of Texas children every year. PUC averages a wait time of 2 MINUTES per encounter with a max allowed wait time of 5 minutes. If a telemedicine provider takes longer than 5 minutes or requires future appointments be set, the program will crater as this will become cumbersome for the nursing staff and utilization will drop. For this program to work, the students can't be waiting around in the nurse's office for extended periods of time. We have real examples of this exact problem occurring in districts in DFW that are serviced by a hospital system. Creating an on-demand system is complex but PUC has successful implanted it and sees on-demand telemedicine visits across Texas every day.</p>	DialCare telemedicine consultations have an average wait time of 15 minutes.

Waiting time may vary 0 to 15 minutes depending on the daily schedule.	<p>Many mental health visits (medication refill visits, etc) that are non-urgent can be appointment based and can be scheduled around the student's needs. For urgent mental health visits, a provider can be available within one hour of the visit request.</p>	Appointments must be scheduled in advance for a session with a licensed counselor. Appointment times are available 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. CT.
61	What role will the counselor play in the program you are offering?	A counselor will be available if needed.	<p>PUC believes the school counselor plays an important part of the process but we also understand this program should not create a whole lot of extra work for the counselor who is many times already burdened with a large workload. The counselor will be integral in both triage of patients and care coordination. They will be responsible for recognizing when a child is a good candidate for telepsychiatry and assisting in getting the visit started but then will not be required to attend the entire visit. After the visit, they will assist in coordinating the next steps for the patient's care along with our care coordination team.</p>	Licensed counselors provide guidance to help members with their concerns whether it is stress, anxiety, depression and more. The counselors are trained to follow crisis protocols. The school district counselor is not expected to play a role in the telemedicine programs, unless it is to help facilitate consent from a parent or legal guardian for consultations. Upon request of the students, counselors may participate in the consultation.

To qualify for the no-cost charity care, the student must have no insurance and be enrolled in the free and reduced lunch program. The district's nurse practitioner will be supervised by one of PUC's medical directors in Texas. The PUC Medical Director would visit with the district's NP in person at least once per month to review charts, procedures, ask questions, receive training and fulfil all other obligations of the supervising physician relationship. In addition to the in-person meetings, the district's NP would have virtually unlimited access to the PUC Medical Director via phone call or video conference for any questions or issues that may come up. The district's NP would also have full access to all PUC provider resources across the entire company. If the district prefers a local provider for supervision, PUC would simply engage with a local physician (accepting input from the district's NP) and hire that local physician to perform the supervision.
