Each Innovation Zone consists of one high school and its feeder middle school(s) and elementary schools. Innovation Zones are represented by a Lead Innovation Zone Principal, who acts as a liaison for and representative of their peers.</p> <p>The role of Innovation Zone Lead Principal is vitally important, as these individuals serve on numerous ad-hoc committees, including the Superintendent's Budget Committee and monthly Agenda Preparation Group (APG) meetings. Additionally, Zone Leaders are tasked with conducting monthly zone meetings; preparing a zone budget; and creating zone goals that drive innovation, provide information and solicit feedback on behalf of our schools.</p> <p>This year's Innovation Zone Principals include: Cherokee Innovation Zone, Jennifer McIntosh of Joseph Knox Elementary School; Creekview Innovation Zone, Michael Santoro of Creekview High School; Etowah Innovation Zone, Todd Sharrock of E.T.
