

Pick up & Drop off procedures





DROP OFF BEFORE SCHOOL

Drop off time is 8:40. THERE IS NO SUPERVISION ON PLAYGROUND UNTIL 8:40.

Students arriving by car may:

- a) be dropped off curbside in the "Drop Off Lane"
- b) walked to the sidewalk <u>after</u> a parent has parked in the parking lot *At no time can cars be <u>left unattended</u> in either drive through lane* Students will then go either to breakfast or straight to the playground.

<u>Students arriving by bus</u> will disembark the bus and go to either breakfast or straight to their playground.

<u>Students walking or riding their bicycles</u> use the sidewalks and appropriate bike racks. Students will then go to breakfast or straight to their playground.

We have two crosswalks to our parking lot. For the safety of all students please ONLY use the crosswalk to go from the lot to the school.

AFTER SCHOOL PICK UP

School is dismissed at 3:15 Monday - Friday

<u>Students leaving by car</u> will be loaded into their car at the designated loading area. This will be one central loading location to ensure student safety. Students will not be allowed to load into cars in the "Drop Off Lane" anywhere but the loading point. They may **never** be loaded into cars in the "Drive Through Lane".

<u>Students waiting for a parent to walk them to a parked car</u>. Parents may request students to wait in the "Hand to Hand" pick up area. Students will wait until their grown-up comes to walk them to their car parked in the parking lot. PLEASE ONLY USE THE CROSSWALKS TO GO TO THE PARKING LOT.

At no time can cars be left unattended in either lane

*Students will never be allowed to cross the "Drop Off Lane" or "Drive Through Lane" without a parent/guardian.

<u>Students leaving by bus</u> will exit the building and walk on the sidewalk straight to their designated bus.

<u>Students walking or riding their bicycles</u> will use the sidewalks and appropriate lanes to leave the school.

Counselor's Corner

Hello families! Welcome to a new school year!

My name is Justine Litzko, and I am starting my 9th year as the counselor at Twin Lakes Elementary. My main job at TLE is to be a support to the students, families, and staff. A couple things about the counseling program at TLE:

- Classroom Lessons: These lessons happen throughout the year in the classrooms. We cover topics ranging from learning skills to problem solving. Last year, if you filled out the district information form regarding these lessons, your student is good to attend this year, too. However, if you are new to TLE, I will be sending home the form for you to complete. In the spring, everyone will be receiving the safety unit permission slip to fill out again. Also, the district curriculum can be viewed at TLE at any time.
- Lunch Bunches: Students throughout the school may sign up to have lunch with me. Rather than eating in the cafeteria, they choose to eat in my

office with friends. We eat, talk, might play a game if there is time, and then students go to recess as usual.

During the first weeks of school, I also welcome all new students to TLE by having lunch with them. New students can choose to eat with me or pass on the invitation. We eat, get to know each other, and they can get to know TLE better and start building connections.

- Group Counseling: Later in the year I will start holding group counseling sessions. Group counseling can be accessed after written consent is given by the family. I will send out more information in the upcoming months.
- Individual Counseling: I can meet with students on an individual basis.

 Referrals can come from families, staff, or students themselves. I can work with students on a short term basis, build skills, problem solve situations, and more.
