School-Wide Positive Behavior Support is a proactive and preventative approach to discipline that emphasizes a positive school climate which promotes appropriate student behavior. The staff at B.F. Morey Elementary School has established rules and responsibilities for our students to learn and live by that provide an atmosphere where students feel safe, happy, and have a maximum opportunity to learn. Our school-wide rules are referred to as *Morey's Keys to Success*.

Throughout areas of our school, there are specific rules and responsibilities that apply.

Arrival & Dismissal: > Use sidewalks and crosswalks > Be aware of traffic > Listen to Duty staff for instructions > Follow hallway rules > Talk softly	Bus: > Remain seated > Face forward > Keep hands, feet, and objects to self > Talk softly > Be friendly to the Driver and other riders	Hallway: Face forward and in a straight line Keep hands and feet to self Walk quietly Stay to the right	Bathroom: Bring only yourself (ex. no pencils, toys) Respect others' privacy (ex. no looking under or inbetween stalls) Use bathroom and flush toilet Wash and dry hands Use equipment properly (ex. no climbing, no swinging) Talk softly Return to class right away
Cafeteria: > Follow adult directions > Stay in line (ex. no cutting) > Talk softly > Use proper table manners > Keep hands, feet, and food to self > Stay in your seat > Sit properly (ex. no sliding on the bench) > Raise your hand if you need something > Keep your area clean	Playground: > Use equipment properly > Take care of yourself and others (ex. no tackling, no pushing, no grabbing) > Stay in designated area > Follow directions immediately (ex. line up when whistle blows) > Only cross the road with Teacher permission	Indoor Recess: Be aware of your surroundings Take turns and share Clean up one item before taking out another Responsible reporting Use equipment properly	Assemblies & Special Events: > Enter quietly > Sit properly (on bottom, legs crossed) > Keep hands and feet to self > Listen attentively > Use audience manners (ex. clapping) Wait for dismissal directions

Our school teaches the following Character Traits to help students follow the rules: **Responsibility**, **Respect**, **Fairness**, **Caring**, **Trustworthiness**, and **Citizenship**.

By following the rules and showing good character, students will be rewarded with a *Key Card*. Students will have an opportunity to exchange their accumulated Key Cards for a prize from their teacher, or they can shop at the *Morey Market* on our monthly *Treasure Chest Tuesday*.
