**Frequently Asked Questions: Policy Revision to Age of Eligibility**

- 1. May a student with a disability who turned 21 and exited during or after the 2022-2023 school term be allowed to re-enroll until age 22?**

Yes. The student should be permitted to enroll until their 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday.

- 2. May the student enroll until their 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday, if a parent/guardian/student signed a Notice of Recommended Education Placement/Prior Written Notice (NOREP/PWN) related to graduation?**

Yes. The student should be permitted to enroll until their 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday.

- 3. Must local education agencies (LEAs) revise IEPs for students with disabilities who are enrolling until they turn 22?**

IEPs should be revised in accordance with the circumstances set forth in 34 C.F.R. § 300.324(b).

- 4. Must LEAs complete re-evaluations for students with disabilities who are enrolling until they turn 22?**

Re-evaluations should occur in accordance with the circumstances set forth in 34 C.F.R. § 300.303(a).
