### September 6, 2023 Meeting Agenda

a. Call to order

Mrs. Goodman called to order the regular meeting of the MISD Livestock Committee at 6:01 PM on September 6, 2023.

b. Minutes of August meeting & Treasurer's Report

Ms. Territo read the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes were approved and Mr. Ward reported the balance on hand of \$53,926.47.

c. Update on Showbook

Ms. Territo has sent it in and getting printed from JK graphics on August 29th.

d. Update on Signs

Waits is ordering no food and water in pen signs for show.

e. Update on electrical trees

Dr. Campbell said they are ordered and ready to go.

f. Update on Cops, Custodians, and Restrooms

Dr. Campbell ordered the cops; the constable is providing them. Dr. Campbell ordered a hotspot for payment stuff. Ward said bathrooms will be there.

g. Update on Shavings

Mr. Lawrence is going to come by and use Mag High's trailer to pick up and bring back to Mag High. Dump trailer full of shavings for ring. We are ordering our bulk order for dump truck shavings. Usually this week before we set up in the barn. Pullin Ranch is the one we purchase from. Small metal dumpster is filled with trash. Intended purpose is for shavings. We talked about moving it out. Make sure to separate trash and shavings for what container it goes in.

h. Other last minute details for show

- Mr. Lawrence is asking for a head count on buyers to give to Buddy Adams. Was told 150 people to feed.
- Booster club wants to instead stock the room with wrist bands and cut the line at concessions instead of having a bunch of different food that will just go bad.
- Wrist bands will go to committee, judges, administration, etc.

- Asked them fee or price. They asked if \$400 will cover it.
  - The pitch is that they are wanting which ever booster club is in charge of the concession stand they are also in charge of hospitality room and get a flat fee to cover it.
  - Dr. Campbell suggested having a hospitality line since it is between shows and don't want to cut people in line and look bad.
  - It has been moved and seconded that we do the concession and hospitality room together for this first time and revisit it in another meeting and that the magnolia high booster club get \$350 to cover this.
  - Mag West Booster Club is coming the Thursday before the show to set up the silent auction. Mag High needs to figure out how many tables are being used and if they can borrow some.
  - Stockingers have said at one time that they could bring a tack trailer. Committee thinks its a need to have some sort of stock trailer. Hillman is asking the stockingers if they can get them to come to our show as a tack trailer. -Stockingers is getting together with Waits on stuff to come to show.
  - We need Waits to print a list of exhibitors for Saturday. We know how many pens to set up.
  - Baked Goods cutting of the piece. We can advise them that the one piece needs to be cut before turning in; per show rules. We are not going to cut it for them.
  - Lawrence is talking to Buddy Adams about drinks. We are asking if buyers dinner can have sweet & unsweet tea, lemonade, and water. Also are cups and ice included. Also as about warmers to keep food warm.
  - Lawrence made a motion that we give \$200 for getting drinks and cups for the buyers dinner to Mrs. Boudreaux to get this done. It was moved and seconded. Canes might donate cold tea?
  - If Buddy Smith is not covering drinks then Boudreaux is going to cover this.
  - FFA Officers are serving food at buyers dinner.
  - Boudreaux and Waits are setting up wooden fences in the cafeteria friday afternoon before show.
  - If kids tags fell out on animals they will be retagged at check in.
  - Additional chairs for buyers to sit in are trying to be found. Doing a count of chairs at the school show set up.
  - Teachers assign cattle stalls
  - Thomas is asking if we can do thank you letters in the library since the band is having a mattress sale in the cafeteria.
  - Majors is bringing a bunny, Territo is bringing turkey and chicken.
