





- Freshman year grades are the foundation; Missteps can be corrected
- All a-g courses must be passed with grades of C- or higher

# **Road to Graduation**

- 220 credits and fulfillment of all subject-specific requirements is the graduation minimum
- Each course earns 10 credits (5 per semester)
  - Freshmen generally earn 60-70 credits during ninth grade.
- A minimum grade of D- is required to earn credit toward graduation
  - Four-year colleges/universities require a minimum grade of C- for most courses
- Failed courses earn no credits, but are calculated in the GPA and remain on the transcript.
  - Select summer school courses available for remediation

Our school hub for student mental health needs. Currently located inside the school library. Student can drop in or check-in using QR codes located around school.






