Fall 2002

The first Big Dog Classic Tournament is held

October 2002

The Teddy Maloney '88 Rink "The Ted" at Proctor Academy is built and dedicated with the generosity of hundreds of supporters and attendees.

Fall 2011

The 10th annual Big Dog Classic Tournament

February 2012

Expansion and dedication of a new entrance, lobby and six locker rooms at The Teddy Maloney '88 Rink

January 2014

Teddy Maloney '88 Scholarship established at Proctor Academy with \$50,000 grant from the Teddy Maloney Foundation, Inc.

September 2015

Proctor junior and varsity hockey player, Jake Pappalardo, is named as the first Teddy Maloney '88 Scholar.

May 2016

Jake graduates Proctor and continues playing hockey at the University of ME, Farmington, while pursuing undergraduate studies.

September 2016

Proctor sophomore and varsity athlete Cole Joslin is named as the second Teddy Maloney '88 scholar.

June 2017

The Teddy Maloney '88 Scholarship endowment reaches \$100,000!

December 2017

Cole commits early decision to play hockey at Middlebury College, VT.

May 2018

Cole is the recipient of The Charles A. Jones award at commencement, awarded to the most outstanding male athlete in the graduating class.

June 2018

The Teddy Maloney '88 Scholarship endowment approaches \$150,000 due to the generosity of hundreds of friends since being established.

September 2018

Cooper Rice '21 named the third Teddy Maloney '88 scholar.

May 2021

Cooper graduates Proctor and proceeds to play Junior Hockey with the Steinbach Pistons, in Manitoba, Canada.

September 2021

Nolan Davis '24 named the fourth Teddy Maloney '88 scholar.

Fall 2021

The 20th annual Big Dog Classic Tournament

June 2022

Cooper Rice '21 is drafted in the North American Hockey League draft by the Minot Minotauros.

July 2022

The Teddy Maloney '88 Scholarship endowment surpasses \$300,000 due to the continued generosity of hundreds of friends since being established.

November 2022

The 20th Anniversary "Skate for Ted" Hockey Game played in the Teddy Maloney '88 Rink at Proctor.

May 2024

Nolan graduates Proctor and will play Junior Hockey before heading to St. Anselm College, NH.

June 2024

The Teddy Maloney '88 Scholarship exceeds \$450,000!

September 2024

Axel Black '26 is named the fifth Teddy Maloney '88 scholar.
