**GRADING**

**Q: How does grading work at the E-Laker Online?**

A: ELO Grading Scale:

E-Laker Online uses the following grading scale to determine final grades for all of their courses.

A	90%-100%
B	80%-89%
C	70%-79%
D	60%-69%
F	Below 60%

**Q: My student(s) always got A's and B's in the past, why aren't they getting A's and B's this year?**

A: Academic difficulty increases every year throughout the school experience. Earning certain grades or evaluations in a previous grade does not guarantee performance at the next grade level. Remember that academic performance is tied directly to several factors like familiarity with the content, amount of effort put into coursework, assessments and/or relearning required to perform at a high level. *In online schooling, persistence, motivation to stay on-task, and the ability to communicate online are skills for success.*

**Q: What should I do if my child is struggling in a class?**

A: Please reach out to the teacher directly. They will be able to provide the most detailed information about why your child has a certain grade and what they can do to improve academically in that subject area. Our Counselor is also a great resource for students when they are struggling academically as they can provide support and ideas for improvement as well. *Weekly contact will be required and progress is mandated.*
