The PSAT measures ELA & math proficiency. It also gives 11th graders the opportunity to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program. This test also serves as an opportunity for Alg 1 EOC concordance.

The SAT measures
college readiness in ELA
& math & is a common
college entrance exam.
It also serves as an
opportunity for ELA &
Alg 1 EOC concordance
& Bright Futures
Scholarship eligibility.

The ACT measures college readiness in English, math, reading, & science & is a common college entrance exam. It also serves as an opportunity for ELA & Alg 1 EOC concordance & Bright Futures Scholarship eligibility.

The Classical Learning
Test measures college
readiness in Verbal
Reasoning, Grammar &
Writing, and Quantitative
Reasoning & is a college
entrance exam. The CLT
serves as an opportunity
for ELA & Alg 1
concordance & Bright
Futures Scholarship
eligibility.

The ASVAB is a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities & helps predict future academic & occupational success in the military.

These exams are typically taken at the end of the year. There are multiple retake options throughout the school year.

The PSAT is given nationally once a year, each October. FPCHS offers this exam during the school day for free for all 10th & 11th grade students.

The SAT is offered for free during the school day in the spring of a student's 11th grade year.

Otherwise, students can visit collegeboard.org to register & pay for Saturday testing.

Saturday SAT testing is not affiliated with FPCHS, but FPC often hosts the exam.

Students can visit act.org to register & pay for Saturday testing. Saturday ACT testing is not affiliated with FPCHS, but FPC often hosts the exam.

Students can visit cltexam.com to register & pay for testing. This exam can be taken remotely from home.

FPC offers the ASVAB twice a year in school. Students can visit guidance for more information & to register for the next administration.

Students who are enrolled in these courses must take the corresponding EOC exams.

Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, students in grades 9 and 10 complete PM tests 1, 2, and 3.

For the class of 2024 only. This exam will be phased out after the 2023-2024 school year.

Students who are enrolled in Algebra 1 must take this exam, which counts as 30% of the final grade in the course.

For students who took Algebra 1 before the 2022-2023 school year. This exam will be phased out after the 2023-2024 school year.

Students sit for this exam at the conclusion of their US Government course.

The EOCs count as 30% of a student's final grade, but passing these exams is not a graduation requirement.
