

**Mississinewa Community School's
BUS SAFETY RULES**

1. Stand off of the roadway while waiting for the bus.
2. Cross the roadway ten feet in front of the bus. Wait for the driver signal before crossing.
3. Stay in your seat with your back against the seat when bus is moving.
4. Keep arms and head inside the bus.
5. No unnecessary conversation with the driver while the bus is in motion.
6. The driver of the bus has the right to assign students to certain seats, if necessary.
7. Do not throw anything out of the windows or on the bus.
8. Keep noise level down so bus driver can announce stops.
9. Keep your hands to yourself.
10. Be respectful to the bus driver.

I understand that the following consequences will occur if future bus referrals are written.

1. Notice sent home to the parents
2. Notice sent home to the parents plus a parent phone call
3. Full day of In-school detention (ISD) with phone call to parent
4. Suspended off bus for one week
5. Suspended off bus for the first semester
6. Suspended off bus for the first and second semester

❖ **SERIOUS SAFETY VIOLATIONS:**

In the case of vandalism or violence on the bus, the student will receive the most severe of consequences.
