COMMUNITY

Founded in 1958, Our Lady of Good Counsel High School is located in Montgomery County, MD. Admission to the school is selective and based on previous school records, teacher recommendations, and standardized testing. Students of all academic levels find success in Good Counsel's Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, STEM, Honors and College Preparatory programs. For highly motivated students with mild learning differences, the Ryken Studies Program offers a structured, small-group learning environment. Eighty-eight percent of the faculty hold advanced degrees. Enrollment is currently 1250 in grades 9 - 12 with 323 students in the class of 2024.

ACCREDITATIONS AND MEMBERSHIPS

The school is fully accredited by the State of Maryland and dually accredited by the Association of Independent Maryland and DC Schools (AIMS) and the Middle States Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges. Our Lady of Good Counsel High School has twice been named as a "Blue Ribbon School of Excellence" by the U.S. Department of Education. It is a member of the College Entrance Examination Board, the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS), the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC) and complies with the NACAC Statement of Principles of Good Practice.

CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The academic year consists of a block schedule of 75 minute periods that meet on alternate days throughout the year. Students earn a minimum of seven credits per year with 28 required for graduation.

Advanced Placement | Our Lady of Good Counsel High School offers 21 AP courses. In 2023, 665 AP exams were given with 78.74% of the scores in the 3-5 range. For a full list of AP class offerings please visit www.olgchs.org/ap

International Baccalaureate | Our Lady of Good Counsel High School offers 22 IB courses. In 2023, 36 IB subjects were examined with 37 of the 45 candidates in the class of 2023 receiving the IB Diploma. Students apply for entry into the International Baccalaureate program their sophomore year and begin taking the IB curriculum their junior year.
