WHEREAS, a number of public school districts in Nassau County wish to jointly solicit proposals for Special Education Related Services to commence in the 2022-2023 school year in accordance with the applicable provisions of General Municipal Law;

WHEREAS, the Glen Cove City School District desires to participate with these school districts for the joint solicitation of proposals for Special Education Related Services as authorized by General Municipal Law Section 119-o, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the attached Inter-Municipal Cooperative Agreement ("IMA") among the participating school districts; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined that it would be in its best financial interest to solicit proposals for Special Education Related Services on a cooperative basis;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the School District to participate with other Nassau County public school districts for the solicitation of proposals for Special Education Related Services on a cooperative basis, subject to the terms and conditions of the IMA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby accepts and approves the appointment of Nassau BOCES as the Lead Participant for purposes of facilitating and coordinating the solicitation of proposals in accordance with the IMA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby approves the attached IMA and authorizes the Board President to execute the IMA on behalf of the Board of Education.

X. New Business

A. Adoption of Investment Policy

WHEREAS, the Glen Cove City School District is required to adopt, by resolution, a written investment policy in part to ensure that deposits and investments are adequately safeguarded and collateralized, as necessary.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Glen Cove City School District recognizes the importance of safeguarding public funds;

WHEREAS, certain banks, with whom the School District seeks to conduct business, have limited forms available for collateralization;

WHEREAS, the School District wishes to expand the options available to the School District in the investment policy to include additional forms of collateralization permitted by General Municipal Law; and

WHEREAS, Policy 2410 permits policy revision upon a first reading if such revision is determined to be necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education accepts Investment Policy No. 6240, as revised.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Investment Policy is hereby adopted and shall become effective immediately without the need for a second reading given the School District's impending financial needs.
