GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Florida Christian School requires 26 credits for graduation. One credit is awarded for satisfactory completion of a full-year course. One-half credit is awarded for satisfactory completion of a semester course. A minimum of 100 hours of community service are required for graduation.

- AP and Dual Enrollment courses receive an incremental increase of 1.0.

COVID-19: OUR RESPONSE

In March 2020, Florida Christian School shifted its instruction to a virtual platform following the regularly scheduled Spring Break. School days were not missed and the curriculum was unchanged. Florida Christian School maintained the same high expectation it has always held for its students. The following school year, students were given the option to return to campus or join live classes remotely using Microsoft Teams. 90% of the high school population attended in person.
